The FIMCAR Project in Brief

The objective of the FIMCAR project is to propose a frontal impact assessment approach addressing self and partner protection. In order to achieve this goal, FIMCAR has analysed European accident data involving new cars and is assessing different full width, off-set as well as MDB test procedures. The selection of the final procedures will be based on testing, numerical simulation and theoretical analysis of frontal impacts. It is expected that FIMCAR will propose a suite of two test procedures consisting of a full width and an offset test. The project is co-funded by the European Commission within the 7th framework programme under the Grant Agreement no. 234216.

The Workshop in Brief

The purpose of the workshop is to present FIMCAR results to date and to discuss them with the input of the participants in order to define the best way forward. Special workshops sessions are dedicated to each of the candidate test procedures in the afternoon. Participants are invited to present their own findings, conclusions and expectations to enhance the discussions and ensure the best way forward.
